

IOP Intern Opportunities 2011

Background:

The Institute of Physics is looking to appoint an intern to work in each of the following areas, which will be determined prior to interview, for a period of two to three months over the summer of 2011:

- Science Policy
- Business & Innovation Policy
- Diversity Projects
- Schools Careers Resources.

This opportunity will allow successful candidates to gain invaluable experience of working in one of the aforementioned areas, supporting the activities of the Institute in:

- researching information in support of responses to consultation documents;
- researching information in support of case studies to highlight the societal impacts of physics research;
- the organisation of meetings, seminars and other events;
- writing and editing material to make it accessible for school students;
- researching and preparing statistical bulletins.

The Institute will provide an allowance (£1,190 per month – tax and NI will be deducted where applicable) for the duration of the internship (35 hours per week).

Eligibility:

Candidates will either have recently completed an undergraduate degree in physics, at a UK or ROI university, or be entering the final year of their undergraduate physics degree in October 2011, and have the right to work in the UK. Candidates should also have a keen interest in the Institute's policy and advocacy activities.
